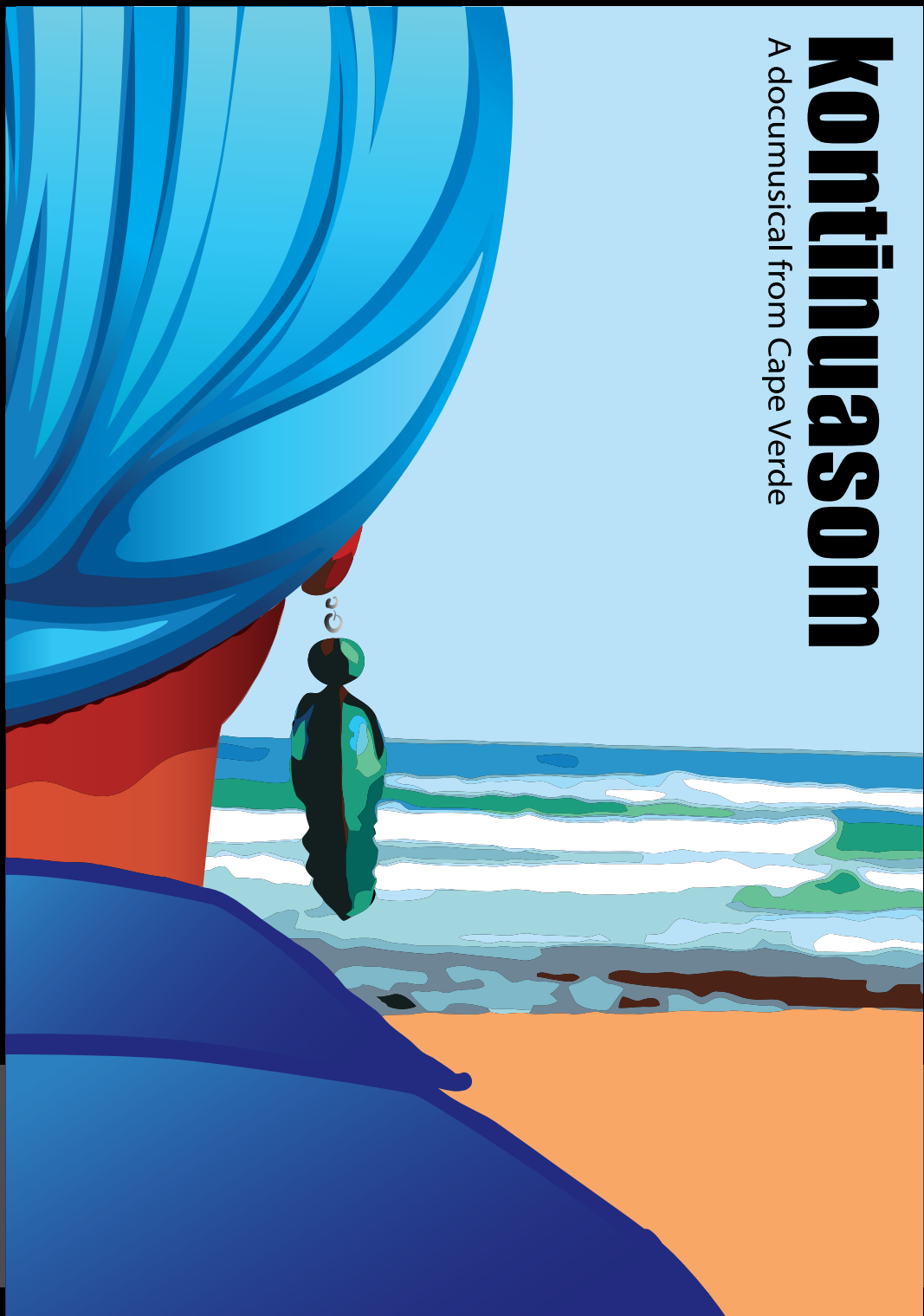

## dossier **Kontinuasom** presentation

Beti lives in her homeland - Cape Vert - where she is a dancer in the company Raiz di Polon.

When she is offered the chance to join a Cape Verdean music show in Lisbon and launch a new career for herself in Portugal, it sets off a deep and essentially Cape Verdean conflict inside - the identity constructed over the centuries by the diaspora of her people.

Doubts and feelings of melancholy and homelessness hang over her and accompany her as she attempts to make her decision. It is the same internal conflict experienced by every Cape Verdean between the desire to leave and the wish to go home.

All of this is expressed through music, the hallmark of the Cape Verdean people.

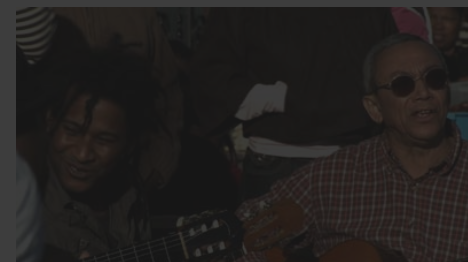
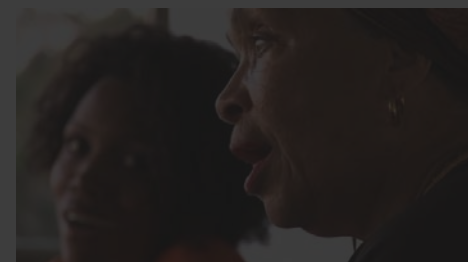

## dossier **Kontinuasom** biofilmography

Óscar Martínez.

Óscar Martínez was born in Linares (Jaén, Andalusia) in 1973. He studied Audiovisual Communication in Madrid.

Scriptwriter for television programs and series, press editor and playwright, he directed his first short, Meme (2001) that won the Arte Joven Award of the Autonomous Community of Madrid in 2001.

In 2004 he directed his first full-length documentary, El violento oficio de la historia, a film about Francisco Olaya, as a historian, an anarchist and as a person.

Óscar founded the production company UTOPI in 2004, through which he directed and produced several projects and audiovisual works.

The collaboration between ASAD, ANIMASUR and UTOPI emerged in 2009 leading to his direction of Kontinuasom, documusical set in Cape Verde.

Óscar is currently dedicated to the development of a new artistic discipline: the Stage Virtual Interactivity, and to the design and programming of the Stagebot, a stage robot.

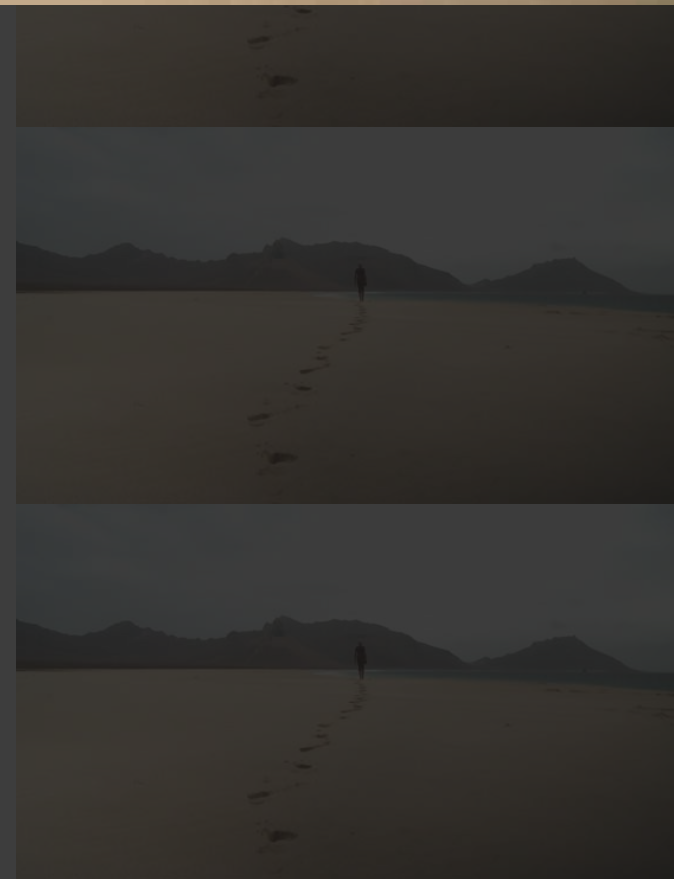
